WHO IS IT FOR?

This is a work-based top up degree and is aimed at those who are working or hope to work with Children from birth to the end of Key Stage 2, in an Education, Early Years or Social Work context.

WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS?

You must have achieved 120 credits at Level 4 + 5 Foundation Degree, within the last five years. You will be required to work with children from birth to the end of Key Stage 2 for at least 50 hours whilst studying the course.

WHAT WILL YOU STUDY?

Modules will build on your practical knowledge and skills at Level 4 and 5 and include:

- Equality & Diversity
- Contemporary Issues
- Learning in the Outside Environment
- Leadership and Management
- Dissertation

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The total cost of this course is £5,995 fully funded through the Student Loan Company. Tuition fee loans are available, plus other maintenance loans depending on individual eligibility.
