



POLICY STATEMENT ON
PROVIDER/
EMPLOYER ACCESS



Introduction

This policy statement sets out the colleges arrangements for managing the access of providers/employers to students at the college for the purpose of giving them information about the providers education or training offer or an employers training or work offer. This complies with the College's legal obligations under section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Student Entitlement

Students are entitled:

- To find out about Higher Education, Apprenticeships (including Degree apprenticeships), traineeships, college leaver programmes and jobs, gap years, study abroad, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the variety of progression routes available to them when they leave Cardinal Newman
- To hear from a range of local providers/employers about the opportunities they offer through internal college events and to engage with activities arranged via careers and the curriculum areas (both internal and external)
- To understand the opportunities available and how to apply

Access will be to interested groups who choose to attend an advertised event or by hosting a stand at our internal events held annually and at other relevant times throughout the year and in some instances via curriculum areas.

Requirements will be discussed and agreed in advance of the visit with the careers leader/careers officer.

Providers/employers are welcome to leave copies of their promotional material and these will either be placed in the careers area or disseminated to the relevant curriculum area.
